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Day One – Johannesburg/ Victoria Falls / Hwange

Arrival in Victoria Falls, meet and greet at the Victoria Falls Airport and transfer to Hwange National Park.

Day Two & Three

SOUTH AFRICA CLIMATE

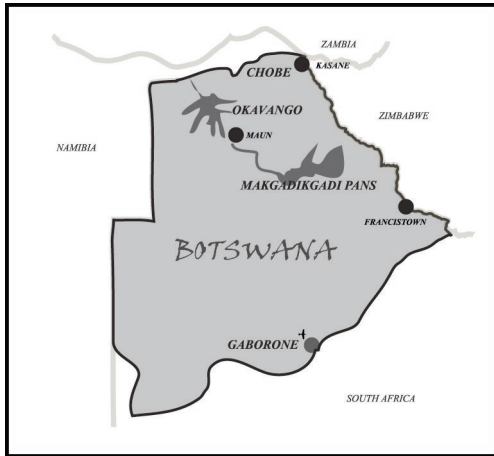
South Africa enjoys a high number of clear, sunny days. Summer in South Africa lasts from October until March. Despite regional differences, South Africa's climate is generally mild throughout the year. Snowfall is limited to the highest mountain peaks, and it is a relatively dry country with a mean annual rainfall of 502mm.

- White Water Rafting - Does not generally run in the high water season (Mar-Jul), but does depend on the amount of rainfall during the wet season (Nov-Feb).
- During the wet months (Nov-Feb) the canoeing can be affected by the rains, and camping can be unpleasant.
- The best time to visit is from April to October.
