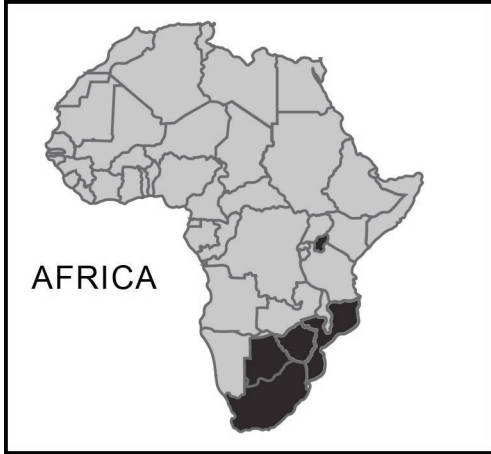

## SOUTH AFRICA CLIMATE

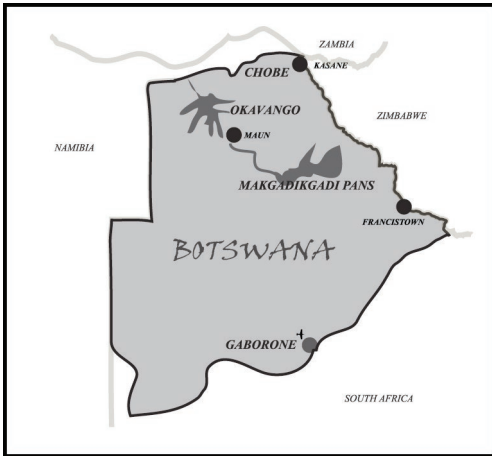

Despite regional differences, South Africa's climate is generally mild throughout the year. Snowfall is limited to the highest mountain peaks, and it is a relatively dry country with a mean annual rainfall of 502mm.
